

ELL – English Language Learner.

Students with limited English proficiency that are serviced by the ESOL program.

ESOL – English to Speakers of Other Languages designed to assist students that are not proficient in English.

GMAS - Georgia Milestones Assessment System. A comprehensive summative assessment program spanning grades 3 through high school.

RTI – Response to Intervention. A multi-tier approach to the early identification and support of students with learning and behavior needs.

SST – Student Support Team. A group that assist the classroom teachers in a collaborative, data-based, problem-solving process designed to identify a student’s instructional needs, strategies and monitoring procedures

STEM - A curriculum approach based on science, technology, engineering and mathematics.

Title I – A federally funded program through the **Georgia** Department of Education for local educational agencies (LEAs) and public **schools** that have a large number of students at poverty level.

Blended Learning - A combination of classroom learning and online learning.

Reading Abbreviations

Reading Counts – A computerized program that tests reading comprehension.

ELA – English Language Arts – Includes Reading and Literature, Language, Writing, and Speaking and Listening

RI-Reading Inventory – A reading test that assesses students' reading skills and gives a lexile measure for students.

Lexile - The measure of a student's reading ability.

Math



ILearn Math - An online program for math that continually adjusts to the student's performance. Teachers are also able to make assignments within the program to continually meet students needs.

READY Math– A 5th and 6th grade math program that emphasizes conceptual understanding through reasoning, modeling, and discussion.

Other Resources

Mobymax – An online adaptive curriculum that creates an individualized educational plan for each student in math and reading and topic related content for other subject areas. Teachers are also able to make assignments within the program to meet students' needs continually. This resource also has math fluency built into it for classroom and home practice.

504 - An anti-discrimination, civil rights statute that requires the needs of students with disabilities to be met as adequately as the needs of the non-disabled are met.
