

Best Student Practices for Home Use:

- Do your own mathematics work. Do your best math without distraction or assistance from others, including friends, siblings, and parents. When others assist you with answers in the program, you may move forward to assignments that are too difficult for you and significantly slow down your progress.
- Date the page and show your work on paper as you would at school; bring the written work back to school to place into your math notebook. Samples of your student work are critical to success and essential to your teacher for providing help when needed.
- If you are having trouble, click on the History Tab at the top of your screen and review the instruction again before proceeding. Your teacher will be able to help you when you are back at school.
- Do not use a calculator unless it is active on-screen in the program.
- Close the program when you are finished by clicking Logout in the upper right hand of the screen.

Log In - Go to www.ilearn.com/login. Click the “Click Here” button, enter your username and password and click the “Login” button. Then click “Start” to begin iLearn Math.

Note: if the “Click Here” button does not immediately load the login page, disable your pop-up blocker.
